This area of development is about supporting children to explore and play with a wide range of media and materials, as well as providing opportunities and encouragement for sharing their thoughts, ideas, and feelings through a variety of activities in art, music, movement, dance, role-play, and design and technology.





Junk modelling is a great way to use the imagination and make rubbish into something fun! Save old food packaging and ask your child to make something. This will also develop their skills at using different tools and resources such as scissors and tape.
